ELIGIBILITY

Contestants must be students of KMTA members.

Piano and Violin—Students in Grades 6–12 are eligible.

Voice—Students in Grades 10-12 are eligible.

REPERTOIRE

PIANO

Any movement of one of the following two Mozart piano concerti:

- Concerto No. 23 in A Major, K. 488
- Concerto No. 20 in D Minor, K. 466

VIOLIN

Any movement of one of the following two violin concerti:

- Concerto No. 3 in G Major, K. 216
- Concerto No. 4 in D Major, K. 218

VOICE

Any Mozart aria

COMPETITION

As part of the KMTA Annual Conference 2012, one pre-college pianist, violinist and vocalist will be selected to perform with the Overland Park Orchestra on Friday, June 8, 2012. The concert will take place in Rice Auditorium on the Baker University campus in Baldwin City, KS.

Submit a CD or DVD of one movement from the eligible repertoire (with piano accompaniment: cuts in the 2nd piano part are allowed) together with the application form and a non-refundable application fee of \$20 postmarked by March 10, 2012.

Winners will be notified by April 10, 2012 and will be expected to come to Overland Park, KS to rehearse with the orchestra at least once during May. The final rehearsal with the orchestra will take place on June 8, 2012 prior to the evening concert.

MEMORIZATION IS REQUIRED.

Winners will receive an honorarium to help defray travel expenses.
