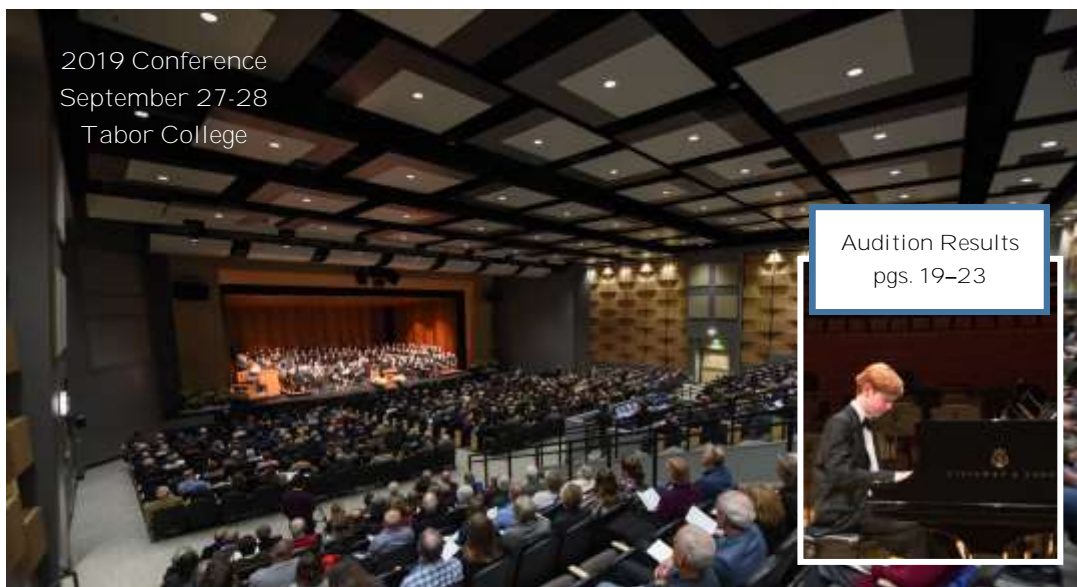

# **KMTA Fall Board Meeting Minutes**

**Beech Hall, Emporia State University  
October 19, 2018**

President Kristi Baker called the meeting to order at 10:15 a.m. and called for approval of the meeting agenda.

Minutes from the 2017 board meeting were distributed to members, and then Pat Ziegelmeier presented the financial reports. Additionally, Linda Featherston reported that we received \$1,900 for conference and publication support during the 2017-18 year, and we recently got a check from Capitol Federal for \$2,500. This will be used for awards at our state honors auditions.

President Kristi Baker gave a report on the MTNA Conference 2018. Then Dan Masterson, immediate past president, shared his work as liaison to KMEA this past year. Our presenters at the February KMEA ISW will be Demaris Hanson (I Don't Just Teach Music, I Teach My Students to be Good People); and Craig Curry (A Spoonful of Pop Music Helps the Music Theory Go Down). KMTA will have no presenters fees since we are using the KMEA sessions submission process.

There was discussion on the need for a chairperson to help us have better communication within our organization. After discussion it was decided that President Baker will create an advisory position on the board for this. Sally Buxton is willing to serve in that position.

Nancy Blockcolsky reported that the KMTA history files which have been housed at Kansas State University in recent years are safe despite a fire at KSU last summer. The historical files all appear to be intact but are not in order now.

Several motions came before the Board, but we did not have a quorum at the meeting to pass them. Therefore, Kristi emailed the following motions to the voting board members for their approval:

Linda Featherston moved to approve the agenda. Dan Masterson seconded the motion.

Dan Masterson moved to approve the minutes of the 2017 fall board meeting as read. Nancy Blockcolsky seconded the motion.

Dan Masterson moved to allow himself, as KMEA/KMTA Liaison, the authority to give KMEA Honors Recital participants some kind of voucher in honor of their work. The overall total would be \$150.00 or less and would replace the recital reception which we have held in the past. The motion was seconded by Linda Featherston.

Linda Featherston moved NOT to have the booth at KMEA ISW this year but rather to do a hand-out flier to promote KMTA at our sessions. Dan Masterson seconded the motion.

Nancy Blockcolsky moved to approve the Local Association Grants as presented by Leona Dickman, Local Association Chair. Karole Erikson seconded the motion.

Nancy Blockcolsky moved to adjourn the meeting. Karole Erikson seconded the motion.

All voting members approved these actions, so the motions passed unanimously.

## KMTA Fall Board Meeting Minutes, cont'd.

In other action, the office of president-elect was discussed. According to the bylaws, that office may be filled by appointment of the president during a non-election year but that appointee must be voted on before he or she can assume the office of president. President Baker reported that there has been interest in that position, so she is appointing J. Bradley Baker to the office of President-Elect for the remainder of the current term. Jen Stephenson of Tabor College will be the new Vice-President for Conference.

## Outstanding Teacher Award & Outstanding Service Award

KMTA presents two awards each year to members who are making contributions to our state organization and to the music profession overall. Forms and instructions are available at the KMTA website, ksmta.org. Individuals or associations nominating a teacher should submit the nomination forms and any supporting materials to Reena Berger Natenberg by April 14, 2019. The awards will be presented at the KMTA State Conference to take place in Fall 2019. It is preferable that nominations be emailed to: [reenarb@yahoo.com](mailto:reenarb@yahoo.com). You may also mail your nomination to: **Dr. Reena Berger Natenberg**, Pittsburg State University, Music Department, 1701 S. Broadway, Pittsburg, KS 66762.

**Outstanding Teacher Award:** Anyone may nominate a teacher for this award: another teacher, a parent, a local teaching association, etc. One award may be given per year to an active KMTA member. This is considered to be a “local” award; a nominee who is active on the local level may receive this award, whether or not he/she has ever served on the state board. It focuses especially on the teaching aspect of a member’s activities. The award may be received more than once by a teacher.

**Outstanding Service Award:** Only a KMTA board member or local association may nominate a teacher for this award. One award may be given per year to an active KMTA member. This is to be considered a “state” or “national” award; the winner of this award will be someone who has made significant contributions to the state organization or to MTNA or to the profession at large. The award focuses especially on the service aspect of a teacher’s role. A teacher may receive the award more than once.
